

PARKING POLICY

The Islamic Center of Pittsburgh is located in a residential parking permit area of the Schenley Farms Historical District. Visitors to the ICP may legally park in the area for up to one hour without a parking permit. This is in effect every day from 7am – 7pm, except for Sundays.

Given this allowance, the below policies will be strictly enforced to ensure the safety, efficiency, and needs of the ICP Community and Staff.

- We have allotted several, labeled parking spots for staff and workers of the ICP. Nobody is to
 park in these spots at any time other than staff members of the ICP. Cars parked illegally
 in the driveway can cause staff and workers much unnecessary delay and inconvenience in
 fulfilling their duties.
- We will issue **one warning** to anybody found parking illegally in our driveway. The license plate number will be noted, and upon a second violation **we will tow the vehicle**. Towing costs will be at the vehicle owner's expense. The towing company is 'Howard's Towing' and can be contacted via phone at 412-292-0590.
- To strike a balance with the needs of community members and staff, we have allotted five
 rental spots, which are clearly labeled. We issue parking badges for these vehicles, which
 must be clearly displayed on vehicle dashboard. Anybody found parking in these areas
 without a valid ICP Parking badge will be towed.
- Under no circumstances are visitors of the ICP to block or park in our neighbors' driveways. Anyone found blocking driveways will be reported to the authorities without warning.
- The ICP will not be held responsible for any tickets or fines received while parking near the ICP premises for any reason.
